As health officials continue to take steps to prevent the spread of COVID-19, schools can play an essential role in this effort. Devils Lake Public Schools believes that athletics and co-curricular activities are essential for the physical, mental, and social wellbeing of our students. We are in support of the decision by the ND High School Activities Association to offer fall sports, with strict adherence to protocols that have the health and safety of participants and coaches/advisors in mind.

While a difficult decision, Devils Lake Public Schools has decided to not allow spectators at our home events at this time. This decision will be evaluated weekly by the Devils Lake Health & Safety Smart Restart Assessment Team as they determine what phase our school district will be operating under.

**Live Streaming:** The Devils Lake Public School will be streaming as many events as possible through the NFHS Network. We now have cameras set-up at Roller Field, Burdick Arena, and the Sports Center. Devils Lake Public School has also purchased the NFHS subscription fee this year so that all our regular season home events at these venues will be free to the public.
